

Fourth Grade Supply List: 2025-26

- Small zip-up pencil pouch: soft, NOT hard, so it fits in desk
- 12 Ticonderoga pencils (less breakage, last longer)
- Clear-view binder: 1 inch, any color (a two-inch binder is too large)
- $^\circ$ Please be sure it has the clear pocket on front
- 1 pack of 5 dividers: pockets preferred, but not necessary
- 2 sturdy, two-pocket folders
- 1 highlighter, any color
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of broad tip markers
- 1 roll of 3M or Scotch brand painter's tape (other brands do not adhere well)
- 1 wide-ruled composition notebook: any color/design
- 1 package of wide-ruled lined paper
- 6-8 dry erase markers:
- Fine tip or chisel tip: student's choice (to be used on individual whiteboards)
- $^{\circ}$ $\,$ Darker colors preferred so teacher can more easily track understanding while teaching
- 1 pair of sturdy headphones
- Feel free to reuse last year's pair, if still in good condition
- 2 WHITE erasers: Hi-polymer is best for Art
- 4 black sharpies:
- $^{\circ}$ 2 fine tip
- $^{\circ}$ 2 ultra fine tip
- 1 large, or 2 small containers of cleaning wipes
- MUSIC: 2 pocket PLASTIC folder
- Optional: 1 pair of Scissors (some students prefer to use their own or have a pair from last year, but if you do not want to buy a new pair students can borrow from my set when needed)

Please Note: Water bottles get knocked over often and the spills are a major reason for the stains on our classroom carpets. Please do not send in over-sized water bottles with open straws, tops need to be sealed when not in use.
