July 11-15 Art Around the World

In this camp we will try different art forms that are distinctive parts of cultures all over the world. We will visit six continents through games, music, dance and art. In Japan, we will try origami and block printing. In Chile, we will make an arpillera. Campers will be able to choose activities from a variety of cultures and in many different media.

July 18-21 Jelly on Toast

In this camp, we will paint food, paint with food, and turn food into paint. We may sculpt food, or weave a placemat. We will study the works of artists who feature food in a variety of media.

July 25-29 Study with the Masters

Students will study the work of various artists, learn about the special techniques they used, and be inspired to create their own artwork. Some artists we will look at are El Greco, Magritte, Matisse, Chagall, Miro and Gaudi.

August 8-12 Inventor's Workshop

A combination of STEM and art! Come this week for an exploration of materials and techniques from oil pastels to weaving, painting and drawing to sculpture. An opportunity to experiment with a wide variety of media with an exploratory and playful mindset.

August 15-19 Animal(Art) Planet

Do you love animals? And art? Come and create animal art in all different media. Make realistic and imaginary creations as we learn more about animals all over the world.
